An Act further to amend and extend the Act to establish Mutual Insurance Companies in Upper Canada.

WHEREAS it is expedient to extend the provisions of the Acts of the Preamble. late Province of Upper Canada, passed in the sixth year of the reign of King William the Fourth, intituled, An Act to authorize the Act of U.C. establishment of Mutual Insurance Companies in the several Districts ^{6 W., 4 c.} 5 of this Province, as also the Act passed in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's reign, initialed, An Act further to amend the Act to establish 18 V., c. 120. Mutual Insurance Companies in Upper Canada, so as to allow the establishment of Municipal Mutual Insurance Companies in Upper Canada : Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

I. It shall be lawful at any time for ten freeholders in any Munici- Meeting for 10 pality in Upper Canada to call a meeting of the inhabitants of such formation of Municipality for the purpose of considering whether it be expedient to how called. establish in such Municipality a Mutual Fire Insurance Company; such meeting to be called in the manner provided in and by the several sec-15 tions of the said last above named Acts, and which therein apply to Towns and Villages.

II. All the provisions contained in the said Acts in the preamble to Acts in Prethis Act mentioned, shall apply and extend to all such Companies formed amble to apunder the provisions of the said mentioned Acts, or either of them.
