Interlibrary Loan is the ser- faculty and may take up to vice by which books and other three months to supply mamaterials not available at UNB's library may be obtained on loan from another institution's library. The Harriet lrving Library adheres to the General Interlibrary Loan Code which has been established to govern loans between libraries in Canada and the United States. Since this service is entirely dependent on the good will of the co-operating libraries, it is essential that each library obey the code, and honour the wishes of the lending libraries. The General Interlibrary Loan Code prescribes that:

Interlibrary loan service supplements a library's resources by making available.. materials located in other libraries.. As applied to research for advanced degrees, it is assumed that the candidate in any institution will choose dissertation topics according to the resources at hand and not those which will involve attempting to borrow a large part of the necessary library resources from other libraries.
Interlibrary Loan is NOT a RUSH service. It may take some time to acquire items requested and therefore should not be relied upon as the major source of material for a thesis.

If material cannot be located in Canada, it definitely should not be relied upon. The Library of Congıess does NOT lend to anybody other than
