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The winning putt

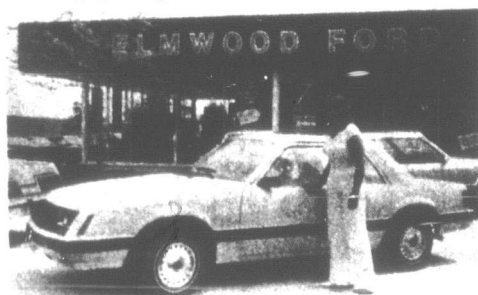

Debbie Schulte won the 1500 and 3000 metres at the first western region track and field meet of the season last weekend at Woodlands track.

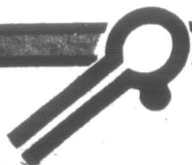
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
