

Appears he did not intend that any law
of the kind should apply to Indians.

Some of the rumors may be an
exaggerated report of his demands,
but as it is important that all bands
within Treaty limits should be brought
into some treaty you will no doubt see
that it is desirable that these Chiefs should
be met and carefully dealt with. At our
treaty you will probably consider out
of the question. I am, however, of opinion
that perhaps two persons with the powers
of Commissioners and a respectable Indian
escort should meet these Indian bands,
explain to them the law, tell them the
terms of Treaty No 6, ^{or No 7} and ask them to give
their adhesion thereto, or to any modifica-
tion thereof that the Government may
deem it advisable to authorizing.

A little special attention of this
kind may be useful in removing mis-
understandings and making known
to the Indians all that the Government
