Variable winds, 6 - 12 m.p.h. Flying began at 0800 hours and continued until 2030 hours under good conditions. Night flying operations carried out at Bienville and Camp Borden. Total flying time 560.50 hours.</p> <p>Harvard II 3764, piloted by P/O J.R. Wright, passenger GB 752595, LAC Hounsell, H.B., went up on its nose on main aerodrome, Camp Borden at 1500 hours. Left brake caught when landing, ground looped. Pilot and passenger uninjured. Categorized C 1.</p> <p>Body of H129229, LAC Parkhill, D.B., missing since August 13 as a result of flying accident, recovered from Georgian Bay near Midland.
