It would have beenbetter had you written the Department
direct in this matter; and you should do so in future whenever you desire authority to dispose of stock.

I have to inform you'in the present instance that the animals referred to may be sold.

I have also to inform you that you are hereby given a free hand with regard to the disposal of enimals during the winter, in the event of it being found necessary, owing to search to feed to rillian dispose of them. You should report the action you take from time to time.
