Sir,

With reference to letter to you of the 19th instant,
(File No 288721) which touched on the subject of the dis-
posal of stock at your Agency, I beg to say that the Indian
Commissioner has written the Department that ~~that~~ you
have reported to him that applications have been made to
you by Indians of the Little Forks Band for the disposal
of a two year old bull and an eight year old cow, which
belong to the holders, but are under Departmental control.
It would have been better had you written the Department
direct in this matter; and you should do so in future when-
ever you desire authority to dispose of stock.

I have to inform you in the present instance that
the animals referred to may be sold.

I have also to inform you that you are hereby given
a free hand with regard to the disposal of animals during
the winter, in the event of it being found necessary, owing to
scarcity of feed, to ~~dispose~~ dispose of them. You should
report the action you take from time to time.
