It seems to be useless to notify you of your indebtedness to this Department on land purchased from the surrendered portion of the Crooked Lakes Reserve, but as this letter may bring a response from you I beg to advise that on the 25th instant there will be due,

Principal ---- \$1,420.65

Interest --- 649.28

Total ---- \$2,05 .93

The above amount be composed of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th instalments and I have to again advise that the money is urgently required for the use of the Indians and that you are expected to forward same on receipt of this communication, without fail, or the sales will be cancelled.
