MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRIME MINISTER

As you know, Stone has been handling all our secret intelligence and liaison contacts with the United Kingdom and United States Intelligence Services, and has been instrumental in the organization of the secret Examination Unit, which has been breaking down Axis secret messages. Their cooperation with the British and American cryptographic agencies has become very close and useful, and our people are making good progress in breaking down new Japanese cyphers which have, for some months, been baffling all the Allied cryptographic experts. We have had a request from the British Security Commission that we take part in a secret meeting, to be held very shortly in London, to consider better means of pooling secret information available to us of Japanese military, naval and political activities. I have recommended that Stone should go. He will go by air and probably be away for some three weeks.
