1. It is recommended that authority for discharge of the marginally named soldier be granted under the provisions of K.R. Can 386(xvi).
2. Pte. Armstrong has been employed on various garrison duties but has proved himself untrustworthy on each occasion, due chiefly to his habits of drinking, having been twice convicted of drunkenness.
3. He is slovenly and unable to shoot.
4. He is 46 years of age and his further retention in the Service is considered undesirable.
