

3. VANCOUVER

Representatives from the Kwawkwalth, West Coast, Cowichan, New Westminster and Vancouver Agencies can conveniently attend at this centre, but it is very difficult to confine attendance to a maximum of 25 while at the same time enabling representation from the many interested Bands. It might be desirable to divide this group and hold a fourth meeting at Nanaimo for representatives from the Cowichan and West Coast and part of the Kwawkwalth Agency to reduce the maximum attendance within manageable limits. I have indicated with a (X) the Bands which could more conveniently be represented at a meeting in Nanaimo:
