## RESOLUTIONS

To be proposed by the Honorable Mr. Harrison, in a Committee of the whole House, on Thursday, the 26th August, 1841, on His Excellency the Governor General's Message, on the subject of

## PUBLIC WORKS.

1. Resolved.—That the following Public Works in this Province should be undertaken and completed under the superintendence of the Board of Works, and that the sums severally mentioned should be granted to Her Majesty for that purpose—

## CLASS ONE.

The Welland Canal, River Richelieu, River Ottawa, Burlington Bay Canal, Internal waters of the Newcastle District, Harbours and Light Houses, and the Roads leading thereto,	2450,000 21,000 28,000 45,000 50,000 74,000
CLASS TWO.	
Bay of Chaleurs Road, Gosford Road, Main Northern Road,  Main Province Road, Quebec to Amherstburg and Port Sarnia, certain portions thereof, viz:	15,000 10,000 30,000
Cascades to Côteau du Lac, Brantford to London, Thence to Port Sarnia, London to Chatham, Sandwich and Amherstburg,	15,000 55,000 15,000 36,000

and that the Government of this Province should be authorized, to raise on the credit of the consolidated Revenue Fund of Canada, the necessary sums of money.

- 2. RESOLVED.—That so soon as a Loan of not less than £500,000 can be negotiated and obtained by the Government of this Province, from any private Company or Companies, at a reduced rate of interest, the improvement of the navigation of the River St. Lawrence should also be undertaken and completed.
- 3. Resolved.—That with a view to redeem the interest on the existing Public Debt of Canada, it is desirable, that the sum of £1,500,000 Sterling money of Great Britain, should be raised, by Loan, on the best terms that can be obtained, under the guarantee proposed and offered in the Despatch of the Right Honorable the Secretar" of State for the Colonies, dated the third day of May last past.—The proceeds of such Loan to be applied, in the first place, to liquidate and pay off the Public Debt, and the surplus to be expended in the completion of the aforesaid Public Works.
- 4. RESOLVED.—That it is expedient to aid the Revenue of this Province, and to afford facility in obtaining a portion of the money necessary to be raised for the foregoing Works, by the issue of Paper, in the name and on account of the Province, payable on demand, so far as this can be effected, with a due regard to the Public faith, and the interests of the Province,
- 5. Resolved.—That such further Revenue as may be required to afford a security sufficient for borrowing the necessary sums, to complete the Public Works so to be undertaken, should be raised by an alteration of the Dutics of Customs imposed on various articles imported into this Province.
