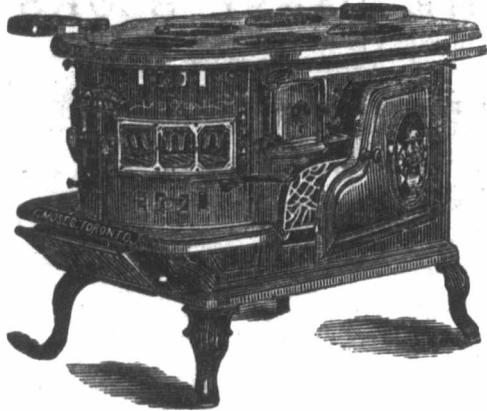
Passengers can embark at Montreal if they so desire. The last train connecting with the mail steamer at Quebec leaves Toronto on the Wednesday morning.

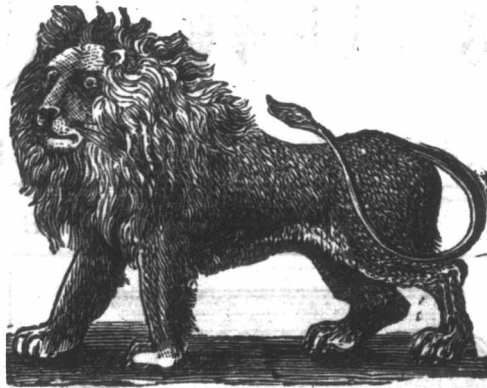

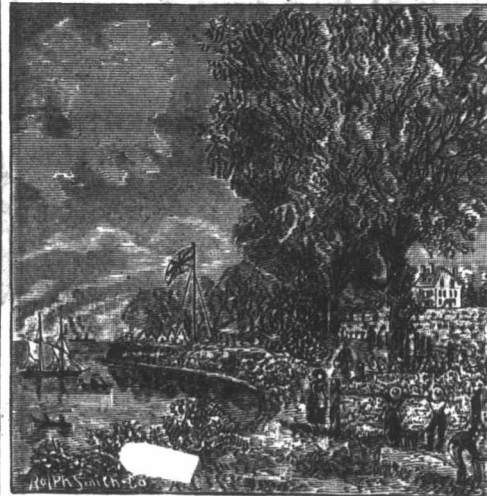
