

A Warm House

-- Cheaply Constructed

Paper treated with it dries out within a few months after being applied to the building, becoming dry and brittle and more porous even than the paper was before being so treated. In fact, tar paper is essentially of less value on a building than plain building paper. Proof of this may be seen in that architects never specify tar paper.
