To our well beloved and faithful the Legislative Councillors of our Province of Lower-Canada, and to our beloved and faithful, the Knights, Citizens and Burgeffes of the House of Affembly of our faid Province, called and chosen to

our prefent Provincial Parliament of our faid Province, and to all our loving Subjects whom these presents may concern, Greeting: Whereas we have thought fit by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our faid Province of Lower-Canada, to ditolve this prefent Provincial Parliament of Our faid Province which: now flands prorogued to Friday the fifteenth day of June inftant; We do for that end publish this Our Royal Proclamation, and do. hereby diffolve the faid Provincial Parliament accordingly, and the Legislative Councillors, and the Knights, Citizens and Burgeffes of the House of Aflembly, are discharged from their meeting and attendance on Friday the fifteenth day of June instant; And We being defirous and refolved as foon as may be, to meet Our people: of Our faid Province, and to have their advice in Provincial Parliament; do hereby make known Our Royal Willand Pleafure to call anew Provincial Parliament, and do hereby further declare that with theadvice of Our faid Executive Council, We have this day given Orders. for iffuing out Writs in due form, for calling a new Provincial Parliament in Our faid Province, which Writs are to bear Teft on Monday the Eighteenth day of this prefent month of June, and to be returnable on Monday the fixth day of August next, for every. place except the County of Gaspé, and for the County of Gaspé on Tuesday the twenty-fifth day of September next.
