

# CAMPAIGN HAS BEEN RESUMED

**Winston Churchill Issues Address to Dundee Electors**

**Declares Forces of Reaction Are Gambling With Nation's Freedom**

**Balfour Recovered -- T. P. O'Connor Back -- A Poster Campaign**

LONDON, Dec. 28.—After a brief Christmas truce the election campaign has resumed with renewed vigor. Winston Spencer Churchill, President of the Board of Trade, has issued a long address to the Dundee electors in which he says:

"The forces of reaction are out for a double event. They are gambling with the right and freedom of the nation and they are running a tremendous risk to win a tremendous prize. That prize is no less than the complete tying up of the democracy, both through its politics and its industry."

Mr. Churchill does not mention the government's Irish policy or the other planks of its platform, but concentrates his whole attention upon warning the electors against the peer's double conspiracy to secure the house of lords veto and the protectionist system.

A. J. Balfour, leader of the opposition in the House of Commons, has recovered from his illness and shortly will begin his campaign speeches. Lord Rochford addressed a meeting in the east end of London tonight but had a hostile reception.

T. P. O'Connor, fresh from his American tour, addressed his constituents in Liverpool this evening and was received with enthusiasm.

John Dillon, M. P. for Saint Mayo, addressed a meeting in London tonight and declared that in the whole record of English government since the Act of Union was passed, no government had ever treated Ireland so generously as the present government.

There will be 10,000 meetings this week alone, 4,000 of which will be held in the towns and villages. The campaign and scores of millions of leaflets have been issued.

The Morning Post expresses the view that the London home counties are safe. It estimates that the following will be the result of the election: Liberals, 278; Unionists, 260; Nationalists, 83; Labor, 40. The Post editorially thinks the raising of the constituency franchise has been a failure, and urges the Unionist to bring tariff reform to the front vigorously on every occasion, and victory will then be assured.

The Daily News thinks the Liberal prospects in London are much brighter than a month back. The Liberal has withdrawn his candidature from Manchester, and a socialist from South Bristol, thus leaving a straight fight.

With the walls and fences covered with highly colored posters and placards, London is being turned into a vast picture gallery. The Tories can claim more artistic work for their posters than can the Liberals. Among the new phrases exhibited are the following: "Radicals shouted against Chinese labor in the Transvaal. Radicals did not shout against Chinese labor in the Transvaal."

"Who shouted for Chinese slavery?" "The radicals." "Who shouted for Chinese pork?" "I have heard of radicals free trade, Chinese pork."

Mr. Ben Tillett, a well known trade unionist leader in the Leader protests strongly against the surrender of the Radical free trade, Chinese pork.

## GRIM HARVEST ON THE N'FD COAST

**11 Schooners with 60 Men Lost in Christmas Blizzard**

**Storm Raged for Six Days—Telegraph Lines Down—Placenta Flooded.**

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld., Dec. 28.—Eleven Newfoundland schooners and their crews of sixty men, are believed to have been lost in the Christmas blizzard, while great destruction to property throughout the island colony has resulted. The storm, which reached its height on Sunday, raged for six days, but today had abated considerably.

All telegraph lines in the island of the colony are down and reports from inland points are slow in reaching here. The town of Placentia was flooded for three days and the principal business street of that place resembles an ocean beach being piled high with foam that cast up by the unusually high tides. The village of Blackhead, three miles from this city, was almost swept away. This December has been the stormiest month the Newfoundland coast has experienced in half a century and it is estimated that its cost to the fisheries and general trade is more than three quarters of a million dollars.

## PRESENTATION TO FOREMAN AT TRURO

**By Railwaymen as Token of His Work in School for Instruction—Enjoyable Social Evening.**

TRURO, N. S., Dec. 28.—The first social evening spent by the mechanical and locomotive staff at Truro after the institution of the school of instruction for employes here was followed by another social tonight, which included feature of exceptional interest.

About fifty employes and a dozen guests were present. The social partook of the character of an evening meeting during the first portion of the evening. Then came an announcement by the chairman, Mr. White, that it had been determined to extend the school of instruction to all branches of the service at the round house. Leonard Kennedy and James Daly were added to the executive committee.

A set of brief speeches from representatives of the foremen, machinists and cleaners followed. One of the latter, a young man named McLean, proved himself a fluent and intellectual speaker. A quartet of singers, led by an expert imitator, responded to calls for a season of entertainment. Then followed the reading of a nicely worded address and the presentation of a gold watch to the foreman of the round house, Robert Wilson. The latter was taken by surprise, but responded most feelingly and uttered his thanks to the men, with words of praise for the interest they took in their work for the railway department and the attention given to the school of instruction. This testimony, it may be noted, was particularly defined as a memento of their regard for him as an instructor and friend. During the course of the evening Mr. Hennessy recalled the appliances formerly in use on locomotives and compared them with those of today. He said that interlocking Railway locomotives of the present day are the equals in equipment of any engines used for similar traffic.

## FOREIGNERS JOIN IN TRIBUTES TO GLADSTONE

LONDON, Dec. 29.—The centenary of the birth of William Edward Gladstone was commemorated today not only in the land of his birth but in countries like Greece, the Balkans and Armenia, whose peoples still cherish the memory of the statesman's exertions in their behalf.

Many foreign delegations joined in services which were held at Westminster. At Haverdwest Mr. Gladstone died on May 19, 1898, and his funeral was fairly hidden beneath floral offerings that had come from all parts of the world while his tomb in Westminster Abbey was covered with tributes including a large solid silver wreath received from the Government at Bulgaria.
