WAR CLOUD IS THICKENING OVER ITALY AND TURKEY

OUTLOOK IN NEAR EAST IS DARK—GREAT BRITAIN AND FRANCE WILL NOT INTERFERE—JERUSALEM SERIOUSLY EFFECTED AND MAY ATTEMPT A SETTLEMENT.

London, Sept. 25.—Great Britain, in common with the rest of Europe, had just settled down to what it was hoped would be a season of peace, after the settlement of the Moroccan question, when news came of a threatened war between Italy and Turkey.

Friends of Italy do not believe that she proposed to take Tripoli with force without having first attempted to settle the differences through diplomatic channels, although, it is admitted, she has serious grievances, including the boycott of Italian goods in Asia Minor and Tripoli.

However, from all sources comes the news that Italy is preparing to force a compliance with her demands with the mobilization of her army and navy and that there is a possibility of ships toward Tripoli.

Turkey's only reply could be the enforcement of a boycott of Italian shipping in the Levant and the expulsion of Italian subjects who have large interests in the country from Turkey.

Italy Will Declare War. London, Sept. 25.—The Daily Mail's Paris correspondent says: "If Turkey executes her threat to expel Italian subjects, Italy instantly will declare war. She is willing, however, to establish herself in any amicable arrangement that will permit Italy to establish herself in Tripoli."

Effect Held Awaiting Decision. Paris, Sept. 25.—A despatch from Palermo to the Temps says that the Italian fleet, consisting of the battleships Napoli, Garibaldi, and Ruggieri, the armoured cruisers and other ships reported ready to move against Tripoli, still remains in the harbor of Palermo. Their departure at Palermo appears to be the result of a decision on the part of the Italian government to await Turkey's final decision concerning a lease of Tripoli under the terms of which that country would remain under the sovereignty of the Turks.

No Hostilities as Yet. London, Sept. 25.—According to the latest despatches received here, no overt act has occurred which would be likely to precipitate hostilities between Italy and Turkey and the hope is held that peace will be maintained. It is pointed out that it is to the interest of all the powers to avoid reopening the near eastern question.

Censorship of Press. Rome, Sept. 25.—The government today issued another warning to the press threatening the severest measures under the penal code against western trip with the British editors.

Germany as a Peacekeeper. Berlin, Sept. 25.—Although Germany has not offered formal mediation it is learned that she is exerting her best endeavors at Rome and Constantinople to bring about a peaceful settlement of the controversy between Turkey and Italy over Tripoli.

Germany regards hostilities between those two countries as a menace to European peace, since it probably would be followed by an outbreak in the Balkans into which Austria-Hungary and other powers might be drawn.

Germany advocates as a solution Turkish recognition of Italy's special point and also of the recognition by the latter country of Turkish sovereignty. Germany's position is a delicate one, as she is bound by an alliance to Italy and by friendship to Turkey.

His Reception for Borden. Ottawa, Sept. 25.—There will be no fewer than five bands in the parade to be held here tomorrow night in honor of R. L. Borden, Canada's next premier. The procession, which will be of large proportions will start from Mr. Borden's residence and return to the same point.
