New York Celebrates
Magna Charter.

In commemoration of the signing of the Magna Charter by King John at Runnymede, England, June 15, 1215, services were held on June 18 at the Cathedral of St. John the Divine, New York. Three stones from the high altar of the famous Abbey of Ely, St. Edmund, upon which the Charter is said to have been laid, were unveiled. These stones were the gift of the Marquis of Bristol to the cathedral, and has been built into the shaft of the credence table south of the high altar. George W. Kierkegaard, Attorney-General under President Taft, and the Rev. Howard C. Robbins, D.D., dean of the cathedral, addressed the congregation, which included representatives from the English-speaking Union, the Canadian Club of New York, the Salvage Institution, and the British School and University Club. "The greater freedom from the oppression which the English-speaking peoples of the world have enjoyed over all other peoples," Mr. Wickesham said, "has been because, from the thirteenth century to the present time, they have held fast to the guiding principles embodied in the charter of John. So let us be thankful for the vision of liberty which the men of this possessed, and rejoice in the stable institutions of our day, by means of which the aspirations of Runnymede have become the accepted liberties of the free, English-speaking commonwealths of the twentieth century."

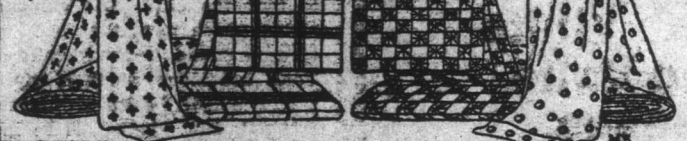
