This film marks the completion of the filming of the Dutton Ontario Newspapers from 1881 to 1975, a joint project of the Regional Collection at The D. B. Weldon Library, The University of Western Ontario, London, Canada, and the Elgin County Public Library. Earlier and later films from this segment are available in both libraries. The cooperation of Mr. Dan Moore, Editor and Publisher of The Dutton Advance, and his predecessor, Mr. H. C. Campbell, made this project possible.

COLLATION STATEMENT

The volume year of the Advance begins and ends in February. Early issues missing are: Feb. 28, Aug. 21, 28, 1924; July 29 and August 5, 1926. Many copies between 1924 and 1929 are worn and frayed, and there may be minor pieces of text missing. The Advance skips an issue in August and in December of each year for a holiday period, which accounts for the apparent lack of issues during these months.
