

STILL IN ABEYANCE.

The Ontario Factory Act—Other Business in the Legislature.

The legislature yesterday cleared the paper of a number of resolutions, principally dealing with affairs of minor importance. In reply to Mr. Meredith's long-standing question as to whether the government intended to permit legislation for the formation of new counties, the premier stated that no action would be taken in the matter. In reply to an enquiry by Mr. Clarke respecting provision for the safety of factory employes, Mr. Fraser replied that the factory act last session was allowed to remain in abeyance until the question of jurisdiction was settled as between the dominion and local government. No decision has yet been arrived at. He might have added that the longer the decision is delayed the better will both governments be pleased.

A motion by Mr. Young for a return of correspondence, etc., between the Ontario government and those of the dominion and Quebec, respecting the final settlement of the financial affairs of the late province of Canada, was carried. Mr. Gibson's amendment allowed the resolution respecting new parliament buildings to stand, and in answer to an enquiry by Mr. Morris as to when he intended to introduce a bill, he replied that he would do so next week. Mr. Harcourt moved for returns for correspondence respecting the admission of women to University colleges, giving details as to the numbers attending classes, the expense incurred, etc. He spoke strongly in favor of the admission of women to all the privileges of the university. The motion was adopted.

Mr. Wood moved the appointment of a select committee to consider changes in the representation of county councils, but on Mr. Fraser's suggestion the resolution was amended to refer the question to the municipal committee and passed in that shape.

The following returns were ordered: On motion of Mr. Wood, correspondence respecting sale of lands to William Coe; Mr. Meredith, correspondence respecting application of Henry S. Mitchell for appointment as notary; also, for names of persons employed as collectors of statistics other than vital statistics; Mr. Lee, for items of expenditure connected with the Model farm crochery.

Then the stage of "public bills" was reached and a large number of measures taken up and read a second time, most of them being amendments to the municipal act. The rural members had a field day, and revelled in the discussion of roads, bridges, township councils, tide drains, and that class of topics.

Mr. Meredith introduced his bill regarding wages giving to employes priority over other creditors in the case of debtors making assignments. Premier Howat expressed his concurrence in the principle of the measure which was read a second time and referred a select committee.

Mr. Wood's bill to amend the public lands act providing that lands of the public for which patents are granted shall be furnished by the department of crown lands to municipalities, which are situated was also read a second time.

The Act Lema Exhibition. The annual loan exhibition of the Art union of Canada is in progress at the rooms of the society of artists, 14 King street west. Many of the paintings on exhibition are superb while others are of a very commonplace order. The painting most admired, and justly so, is one by Franz Deitinger of Munich, "On Furlong," "Autumn," by A. Schack, Düsseldorf, is also an charming painting. Both these were loaned by Mrs. Alex. Cameron, "A Dutch Interior," by J. Renardier, Munich, is also a gem. "St. Cecilia," by Gabriel Max, is an excellent painting, the facial expression being exceedingly good. Among the paintings by Canadian artists the following are perhaps worthy of highest commendation: "Talkers of the Sea," by E. S. Caldwell, Paris; "Somebody's Company," by W. Thompson, Paris; "Loggins," by W. Tuckerman, and the portrait of a newsboy by R. Harris. The art union has been well patronized by the purchase of the opening of the exhibition.

REMOVED, BUT NOT DISCHARGED.

Thos. Bright still Employed in the Sheriff's Office.

After Thos. Bright confessed to having tampered with jurors in the Beaulieu case the sheriff discharged him from his service, at least this is what press and public were given to understand. But this turns out not to be the case. True, Bright was removed from further duty as a court constable, but he is still retained in the sheriff's office, which is part and parcel of the courts. As an official said yesterday, "he will still be employed in serving jurors, carrying messages, and from his jail executing writs and other such work, and at the same time have an opportunity of knowing and assisting in the trial of cases in the sheriff's office." This suggests the question, is it safe to have Bright about the building of all. It is the unfeeling and dishonest conduct as a constable calculated to inspire confidence in him while retained in a public capacity? And further, Bright's case is not the only one where this worthy shone in gully colors. What about the Rheinhardt case, a few years ago? A brief investigation pointed at the time to show Bright up in an unenviable light there, too. Besides being a court constable and sheriff's officer, Bright has been a constable in the county court. But Judge Boyd will doubtless see to it that he does not act in this capacity any further. It is understood the attorney-general ordered Bright's dismissal. He has not been discharged, but simply removed from duty upstairs to the sheriff's office. What is the attorney-general or the sheriff going to do about it?

The British America Directorate. It was reported on the street yesterday that T. B. Wood had decided not to take a seat at the board of the British America assurance company, to which he was elected at the meeting on Wednesday. It seems that during the progress of the voting the ballot papers were cast; more were brought up from the office; among them some of the previous year on which the name of Mr. Forbes was not placed. The two gentlemen, who were supporting the present directorate, got hold of these tickets and put in over 1301 votes for Mr. Forbes (who was not a candidate) when they had intended to cast them for Mr. Warren. Mr. Wood has subsequently announced his decision not to qualify. This course of his cannot be redounded to his credit, as it is better to accept a defeat than to sit at a board on a rick.

From East to West. A number of men just in from Burke's C. P. R. contract west of Sudbury say the rails will not be all laid before May 1. Burke will complete the contract in a couple of weeks. George & McCallan in about a month, but Mr. Eggleston has a very heavy cutting to make some six miles from Dog Lake. This cutting it is expected will not be completed for two months, and of course till it is completed there can be no through-trains. A vast amount of work, involving a heavy outlay, such as filling in grade-work, building bridges, etc., remains to be done, and it will likely be June 1 before through trains are run from the east to the Rockies.
