

YUKON REGULATIONS APPROVED.

The regulations governing placer mining on the Yukon are generally approved here, especially the royalty and the reserved claims clauses. There is some misapprehension as to the royalty. The regulations do not impose 20 per cent on all gold mined when the claim yields over \$500 a week, but 10 per cent on all the value of all the gold mined up to \$500 a week and 10 per cent additional on all gold mined above \$500 a week that is, the first \$500 a week will be taxed 10 per cent, or \$50, and when it goes over that the 20 per cent applies to the excesses over \$500 only. The entry fee is \$15, and the actual fee \$100. In default for 10 days after the demand for royalty has been posted on the claim shall be followed by cancellation of the claim. The gold commissioner is to determine the time of collection and name the collectors. Any attempt to defraud the government will be punished by cancellation. Every alternate claim is to be reserved for the Federal Government and sold for auction or otherwise for the benefit of the public revenue—that is, if a prospector discovers gold on a stream and stakes off his 500 feet, running lengthwise with the stream and covering the bed and both sides of the stream and running back 100 feet, the government shall have reserved the next 500 feet. That is, the first man gets his own choice, but the next man must measure off 500 feet for the government before he begins to measure off his own claim. This provision meets with universal approval in Ontario and Quebec.—Ottawa Exchange.

ALBERNI CAMP.

Mr. George Brown, who is down in Nanaimo from Alberni, reports that a very considerable amount of development work is being done on claims at Clayoquot, Anderson lake and the Alberni canal, and that the western extremity of the copper belt is proving to contain some excellent properties. Mining along the coast has been active in a quiet way throughout the summer, and sales are taking place every week.

In Alberni itself there are now quite a number of people, and trade is decidedly brisk. But little prospecting is being done inside the railway belt, but as a rule men are holding their claims, awaiting developments.

The new strike made a few days ago on the Alberni continues to look better every day, and some magnificent specimens of ore are being taken out for shipment as soon as the new Alberni road is completed, which is expected to take only about a fortnight, the work having been rapidly pushed through with a large squad of men. More important than this, however, a ledge three feet high and assaying some \$3,000 to the ton, has just been discovered and
