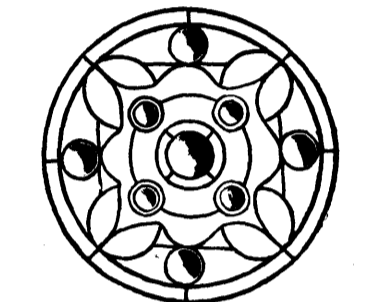


GRIMSBY PARK The Great Canadian Summer Resort. SEASON OF 1894.
