Besides the large tourist trade between the two countries, personal contacts are fostered by various arrangements. An exchange agreement permits up to 25 young specialists and technicians from Canada and Mexico to spend a year working or studying in the other country and secure a scholarship system allows a small number of university students to do the same. Roughly 250 Mexican agricultural workers come to Canada each year to help in harvests. Under a transfer of Orléans Treaty, Canadians and Mexicans may elect to spend a period separate in their own country.
