was not only in line with the general policy of the Government

that Canada has not made any contribution of material directly
or indirectly to the Government of Portugal to make it clear
such measures are necessary.

It is decided upon by the Security Council after consultation with
the relevant organs of the United Nations and in accordance with the
provisions of the Charter of the United Nations. For example,
the Security Council has decided to vote in favour of the resolution

to that effect and to support the efforts of the Government
of Portugal (S/Res 1514 (XV) and 1515 (XV)).

It has been accepted by the United Nations and expressed in resolutions
of the Security Council that the principle of self-determination
of peoples is a principle of international law. It is a principle
of international law which is binding on all States and which is
