The Department of External Affairs announced today that the Minister of Transport, Mr. Lionel Chevrier, will head the Canadian Delegation to the Seventh Annual Assembly of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) to be held in Brighton, England, commencing June 15.

Other members of the Delegation will be Mr. John R. Baldwin, Chairman, Air Transport Board; Air Vice Marshall A. de Niverville, District Controller of Air Services, Department of Transport, Montreal; Mr. C.S. Booth, Canadian Council Member to ICAO; and a member of the Department of External Affairs. There will be Technical Advisers accompanying the Delegation.

ICAO is a Specialized Agency of the United Nations dealing with economic and technical matters in the field of aviation. It holds a major Assembly every three years and administrative Assemblies in the intervening years. The meeting in Brighton will be a major Assembly and will deal with policy matters relating to the work of ICAO in the field of international aviation.
