As I have said, this will require a combination of appropriate domestic policies, adequate financial resources, trade liberalization, sustained domestic and foreign investment, strengthened multilateral institutions, and a more stable international economic system. We have said, and we repeat, that for many developing countries the achievement of viable levels of growth is one of the most critical challenges of our time. Our contribution to its achievement is in our interest as well as theirs.
