PRAYERS.

Mr. Sharp, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid before the House,—  
Budget White Paper 1967-68; Part I—Economic White Paper for 1967; Part II—  
Review of Government Accounts 1966-67. (English and French).

Ordered,—That the said Budget Papers be published as an appendix to  
this day's *Votes and Proceedings* and as an appendix to *Hansard* of Thursday,  
June 1, 1967.

Mr. Otto, seconded by Mr. Roxburgh, by leave of the House, introduced  
Bill C-121, An Act to amend the Canadian Citizenship Act, which was read  
the first time and order for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

Mrs. MacInnis, seconded by Mr. Prittie, by leave of the House, introduced  
Bill C-122, An Act to amend the Criminal Code (Abortion), which was read  
the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

Mr. Wahn, seconded by Mr. Faulkner, by leave of the House, introduced  
Bill C-123, An Act to amend the Criminal Code (Birth Control), which was  
read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of  
the House.
