

The CHAIRMAN (Sir Eugene Fiset): Is it the desire of the committee that we should consider the estimate item by item?

Mr. CHAPLIN: We have already decided that.

The CHAIRMAN (Sir Eugene Fiset): Then this discussion is out of order.

Mr. ADSHEAD: Then the other discussion was also out of order.

Mr. ELLIOTT: As regards Kenogami the postal revenue for 1926-27 was \$8,106, and the population is 2,557, according to the 1921 census, the last that we have.

Mr. GARDINER: What item are we dealing with now?

The CHAIRMAN (Sir Eugene Fiset): Dominion public buildings—improvements, repairs, etc., \$102,000.

Mr. GARDINER: May we have the details of that?

Mr. ARTHURS: And the details regarding Limoilou.

Mr. ELLIOTT: Perhaps I had better give them one at a time. My hon. friend asked for the general details in regard to the amount of \$102,000. That is the amount that has been spent annually for a number of years for improvements and repairs in connection with Dominion public buildings in the province of Quebec, including those in the city of Montreal. Perhaps while I am on my feet I had better answer with regard to Limoilou. Limoilou is practically part of the city of Quebec at the present time. This building is in a rapidly growing part of the city.

Mr. CHAPLIN: What is the population?

Mr. ELLIOTT: It is practically part of the city. There are fifty-six industrial establishments, six religious institutions, 152 stores and 3,200 residential buildings served by this building. I have not the population of this part separately, but it is a rapidly growing suburb of Quebec.

Mr. ARTHURS: I should like a few details regarding the way in which the item of \$102,000 was spent last year for improvements and repairs to Dominion public buildings.

Mr. ELLIOTT: The amount spent last year is \$101,985, made up as follows:
