**Remuneration**

Directors are paid according to Petro-Canada's bylaws, section 7, which states:

"7. Remuneration: Each director, other than a director who is employed in the Public Service or a director who is an officer of the corporation, shall receive the sum of \$500 for each meeting of the board or any committee of the board attended by such director and for each eight hours spent travelling to and from such meeting. A director, when absent from his ordinary place of residence, shall be paid reasonable travelling and living expenses incurred by him while travelling to, attending or returning from any meeting of the board, a committee, any other meeting or other business activity in relation to the affairs of the corporation. The directors may by resolution, award special remuneration to any director of the corporation other than a director who is employed in the Public Service or a director who is a full-time officer of the corporation undertaking any work or service on behalf of the corporation beyond that ordinarily required of a director."
