By the Honourable Senator Beaubien:—

15th February—That he shall submit the following Resolution:—

“That, with a view of completing the inquiry pursued during last session by the Special Railway Committee of this House and preparing and submitting an adequate report on such inquiry, this Special Committee be re-appointed with a view to inquire into and report upon the best means of relieving the country from its extremely serious railway condition and financial burden consequent thereto, with power to send for persons, papers and records and that the said Committee be re-appointed with the same personnel and, therefore, that it consists of Senators Beaubien, Black, Buchanan, Calder, Cantley, Côté, Dandurand, Graham, Haig, Hugessen, Horsey, Jones, Hardy, McRae, Meighen, Murdock, Parent, Robinson, Sharpe and Sinclair.”
