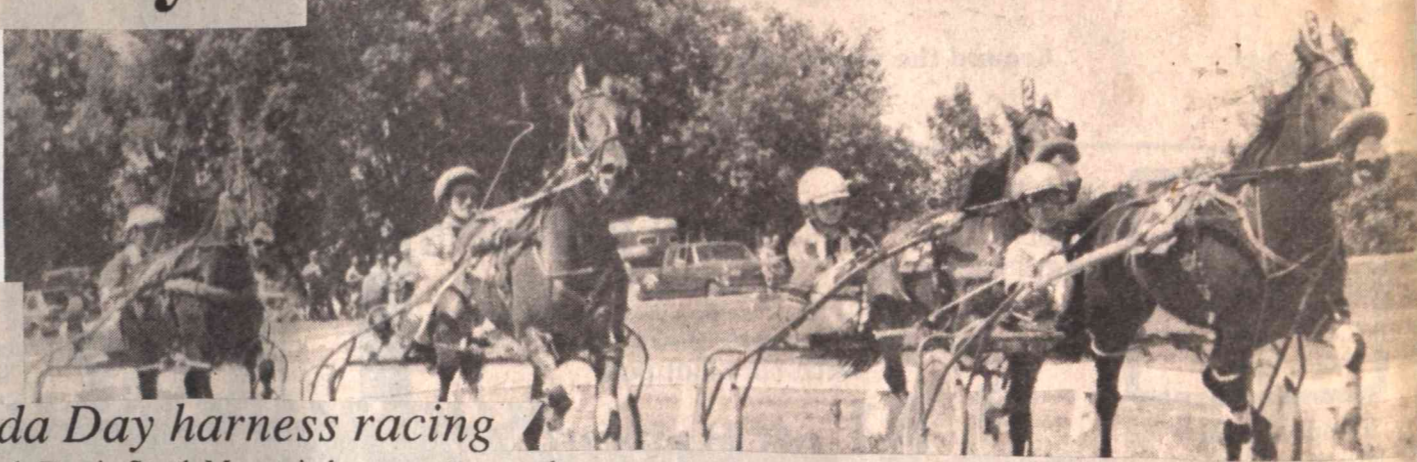


Mountain Twp. celebrates Canada's 124th birthday **Canada Day**

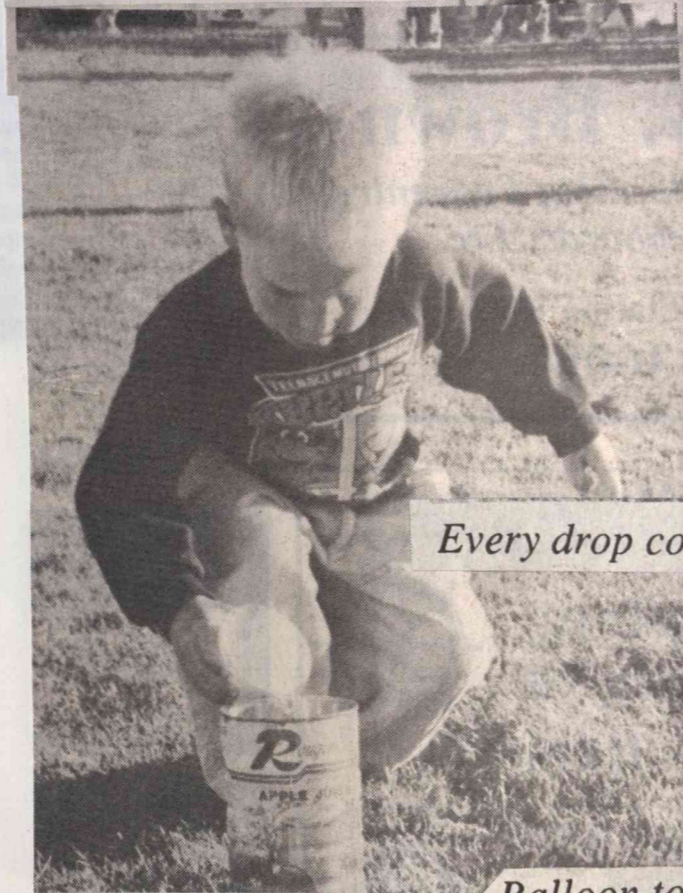

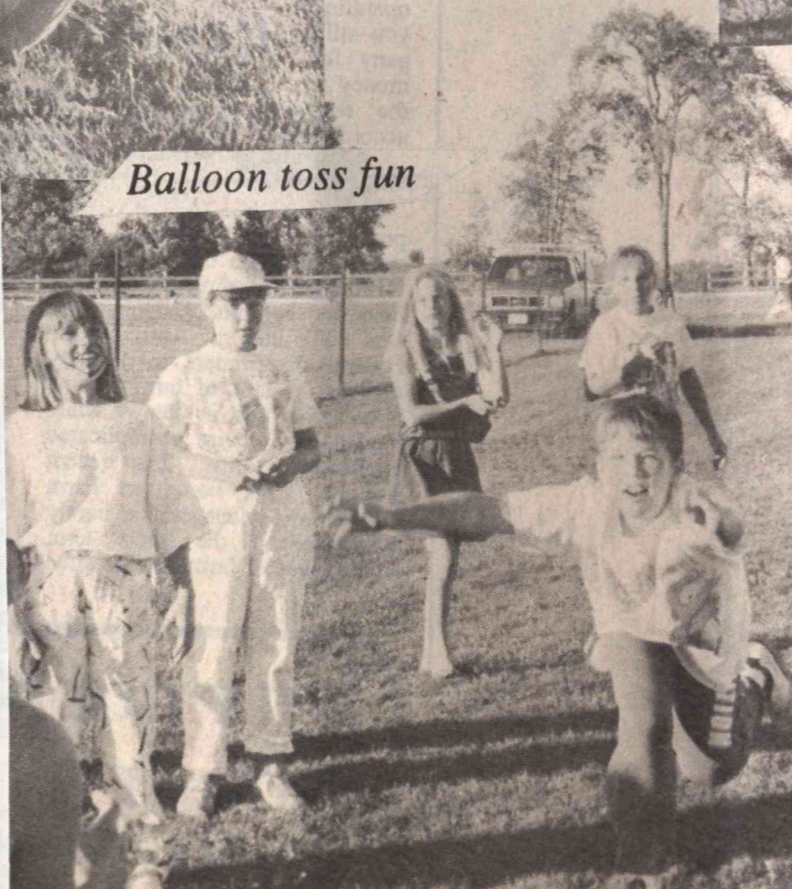
