

Columns Right and Left.—On the word RIGHT, the senior subaltern commands "right column left wheel" and the junior subaltern "left column right wheel."

Forward.—When the movement is executed, the Captain General will give the command, "Forward."

NOTE.—The colors will take position as in the previous movement.

103.—Being in Double Column of Threes, to Re-form Column of Squads and March to the Front.

Reform Column of -Squads.—On the word SQUADS, the senior subaltern will command "threes left," and the junior subaltern "threes right," and when the columns are within squad distance of each other, the Captain General will give the command "threes right and left," re-uniting the threes in squads.

Forward.—When the movement is completed, "Forward."

Re-form Column of -Squads.—Or, on the word SQUADS, the senior subaltern will command, "left wheel" and the junior subaltern, "right wheel," and when the leading columns of threes are within squad distance of each other, the Captain General will give the command, "right and left wheel," when the squads will re-unite successively and cover.

NOTE.—The colors move forward and take their position in column.

104.—Being in Column of Sections, to Form Column of Threes and March to the Front.

Advance in Column of Threes from the Right (or Left), Right Forward Threes—Right (or Left).—On the word RIGHT (or LEFT), the right (or left) three of
