bushels. In cases where this information was not given, the loss is based on the average yields in the the localities as given in this bulletin. On this basis the actual quantity of wheat lost has been 473.140 bushels; oats, 240.482; and barley, 20.908 bushels. These figures must be supplemented by the quantities contained in the partially destroyed acres but which cannot be arrived at.

These figures fall considerably below what was at first thought, from the reports received, the actual loss would be, and should the average yields fall below those used in estimating the total loss will be still further lessened.
