

CONSTITUTION

FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF THE

GRAND LODGE

—OF THE—

Ancient Order United Workmen OF ONTARIO.

1. This Grand Lodge shall be known under the name, Title style and title of The Grand Lodge of the Ancient Order of United Workmen of the Province of Ontario, and shall have jurisdiction over all Lodges and members of the A. O. U. W. in the Dominion of Canada.
2. The Grand Lodge shall consist of its Grand Officers, Executive Committee, District Deputy Grand Masters, Grand Medical Examiner, Grand Solicitor, and the Representatives of the Subordinate Lodges within the jurisdiction who have received the Grand Lodge Degree. Composition of Grand Lodge
3. Grand Lodge shall have an official seal with an appropriate device thereon. Seal
4. All Past Master Workmen in good standing in their respective Subordinate Lodges, within the bounds of Grand Lodge, shall be entitled to a seat, but without voice or vote, and all Past Master Workmen in good standing in other Grand Lodge Jurisdictions, who have received the Grand Lodge Degree, may be admitted as visitors. Rights of P. M. W. as visitors
5. Each Subordinate Lodge in Ontario shall be entitled to one representative, and one alternate who shall perform the duties of representative in the case of the death, resignation or inability to serve of the representative, or of his inability to attend the Grand Lodge, who shall be elected Representation to Grand Lodge
