It states: Murderers, highway-men and burglars make surprising records, while the police watch side doors. Des-perate criminals have been busy killing and plundering. There were 59 crimes in January and 52 in February, mostly of murders, assaults, burglaries and street robberies, and the record "no arrests re-ported" becomes monotonous from its re-petition. It is a calendar of unprevented and undetected crime disgraceful to the po-lice management.
