set British journalists counting up the losses in the war. From Oct. 11, 1890, to June 1, 1902, in all 31½ months of war, the ultimate triumph of the British arms has cost 21,579 lives, or nearly 7 per cent, of the troops engaged.

Taking the killed and wounded together, the casualties work out at 30,120 men, or nearly 10 per cent. of the total forces.

The surrenders of armed men total 9714, or about 3 per cent. of the fighting line. Of these, six battalions, on whom fell the ordinary bad luck inseparable from a great campaign, account between them for 3000 per cent. of the imperial army, in spite of the severe strain imposed, has been remarkable; the figures of 13,000 deaths from disease spread over an average force, of 200,000 men, in two and a half years, giving a nanual death rate of only 25 per thousand.


