Montreal. Sept. 13.—(Special.)—One of the leading Manitoba milling companies advanced their prices Saturday 15 cents per barrel, making the price \$4.65 for patents and \$4.35 for second patents. The advance is apparently warranted on account of the prices now being paid to the Manitoba farmers for wheat; a still further advance may be looked for.
