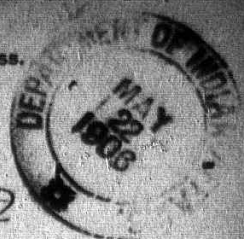

I am directed to say that the Commissioner of the Hudson's Bay Company has applied for 29.75 acres for the Company's reserve at Fisher River Post on Lake Winnipeg. According to the description furnished by the Surveyor-General, of which a copy is enclosed herewith, the area is 19 acres only. In any case as the land lies within the limits of an Indian Reserve I am to ask whether your Department has any objection to its being patented to the Company.

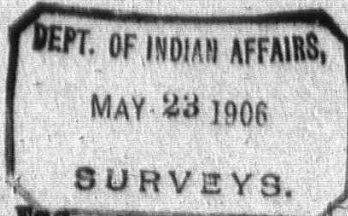
