THIS PROMINENT CANADIAN FAMILY HAS SUFFERED MUCH

Upon very few of the notable fam-ilies of Canada has the war put so heavy a hand as on that of Sir Mon-tagu Allan of Montreal. When the Lusitanian went down off the coast of Ireland he lost two of his three daugh-ter, and his wife was injured. On Monday week official word was rec-orded in Canada that his only son, Flight Lieut. Hugh Allan, had been killed while fighting Huns in France. Thus a family of four has been reduced to one—the sole survivor being Miss Mar-the Allan, who went to England in the fall of 1914, and has since been en-gaged in nursing there and in France. Lady Allan is head of the Canadian Red Cross in London, and Sir Montagu is connected with the Canadian Pensions Board in London.

The whole family being overseas no one but servants have occupied palat-ial "Ravenscroft," one of the show places of Montreal, for the last two years. Situated in Pine avenue, on the slope of the mountain overlooking the city, it is one of Canada's most gorge-ous homes. Even now its conservatories are open every Saturday for the delight of flower lovers.

Sir Montagu is the son of Sir Hugh Allan, one of the founders of the Al-lan Line, which was taken over some time ago by the C.P.R., but which still retains its name. Besides being presi-dent of the Merchants Bank, Sir Mon-tagu is a director of a dozen of Cana-da's big corporations. He is an en-thusiastic horseman, having on more than one occasion annexed the Tor-onto Queen's Plate. He is in the millionsaire class several times over, and has given large donations to public charities.
