Premier King's reply, dated yesterday follows:

"My Dear Sir Lomer:

"I have just received you letter of New Year's Eve, in which you tender your resignation as a member of the government. To our colleagues and the cabinet the word that the state of your health will not permit of your continuing to hold the portfolio of Minister of Justice, and compels your resignation, will be received with a regret second only to that which I myself experienced at the time of your first mention to me of this possibility. I can only repeat what I then said, that it is with feelings of the deepest regret I find in the circumstances you have mentioned, no alternative other than that of meeting your wishes with respect to a respite from the exact-

"It will perhaps remove the possibility of any uncertainty in the public mind if I do not defer the date of acting upon your request, and accordingly I have decided not to delay the acceptance of your resignation. I cannot accept your resignation, however, as I do now, without saying how much "I feel our country is indebted to you for the public services you have rendered during the period you have been a member of the administration; and how earnestly I hope that with freedom from the strain and cares of office, you may be permitted to enjoy
