Montreal, Dec. 26.—It is estimated that it will take ten days to repair the sixty-foot break in the main conduit which has resulted in depriving the city of half its supply of water. So grave is the situation that Mayor Lavalee has issued an official statement suggesting that manufacturing plants shut down for a few days, and warning citizens of the danger of explosion if the hot water is drawn from the taps in the houses.

Daily Hints For the Cook

Drop Hermits. Two eggs, 1 cup sugar, 1 cup molasses, 2-3 cup butter, 1 teaspoon saleratus, 3 tablespoons sour milk, 1 teaspoon all kinds of spice, 1 cup chopped raisins, 1 quart flour. Drop by teaspoon on bottom of dripping pan. Potatoes Anglaise. Boil some potatoes until nearly tender, cut in thick slices, butter a baking dish and arrange the potatoes in layers, putting between each layer sliced bacon and grated cheese. Moisten thoroughly with a little stock or white sauce, cover with grated cheese, dot with bits of butter and bake 1/2 hour. Turkish Pilaff. One and one-half cups cooked meat (beef, mutton or chicken), cut in dice, 1 cup rice, 8 cups water or gravy, 1 cup stewed tomatoes, 1 teaspoon salt. Put water, salt, tomato and meat in sauce-

"77" FOR GRIP, INFLUENZA, COUGHS, SORE THROAT COLDS. THE LATE H. T. STEVENS. How Conservatives Deal With One Who Had Worked For Their Cause (Chatham World) H. T. Stevens, Moncton, died on Saturday, aged 74. He founded the Moncton Times and was a vigorous politician. He was first mayor of Moncton and was once a member of the legislature. Mr. Stevens dreamed a few years ago that he was a rich man and practically withdrew from the management of his publishing and printing business. He awoke, after a year or two of rather generous living, to find that he was deeply in debt and his affairs in a sorry state. His party friends took hold of the business, paid off its liabilities, put it once more on a paying basis, and kept it. Mr. Stevens, finding himself in the street, penniless, resented the conduct of his party friends so strongly that the Liberals gave him a small office in the railway stores department. It was a kindly act and saved the veteran from starvation or the poorhouse.
