#### GOES TO COMMITTEE

New District Will be Known as Province of British Columbia-Nomination of Missionary Bishops Discussed — Greeting From American Church

(Canadian Press) London, Ont., Sept. 8-Legislation when the recommendation of the house bishops for the establishment of the proince of British Columbia was placed be fore the house of delegates.

The recommendation of the upper hou bich outlined the proposed organization was by vote of the lower house sent on t their report prior to the general discussion over the new province.

It is likely that this third province, if it be established at this synod, will be different from the two present provinces—Canada and Ruperts Land—for there is now before the synod a notice of motion by the Rishan of Caladavia the in the
