that this Band learns with regret that white men will not be allowed to come on this Reserve to haul timber cut by the Indians to be sawed into lumber for use on the reserve or wood that may be sold as it is a great waste of time and money to haul it a short distance to the boundary of the Reserve and it will bring as much where it is cut in regard to logs there is so many men that wants a little lumber that the teams owned on the Reserve cant do all the hauling some will be unable to get their logs to the place of sawing we dont see why we should be bound down in this way
