TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES
THE FOLLOWING GRID REFERENCE IS A SAMPLE ONLY
AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THIS MAP

REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH (as above)
EASTING: Road number on grid line immediately to left of point	97
Estimate tenths of a square from this line westward to point	5
NORTHING: Road number on grid line immediately below point	96
Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point	4

EXAMPLE: MILITARY GRID REFERENCE: 975604
Nearest visible grid reference 100,000 metres (about 10 miles)
