

BILL.

An Act to amend the Act 14 and 15 Vic., cap. 4, intituled, "An Act to amend the Act concerning Land "Surveyors."

WHEREAS by reason of the delay which occurred in the dis-Preamble. tribution of the Provincial Statutes, and from other causes, many applicants for admission to practise the profession of Land Surveyor, were unable to transmit copies of their Articles or Indentures within the period fixed by the Act passed in the Session held in the 14th and 15th years of Her Majesty's Reign, and initialed, "An Act to amend the Act concerning Land Surveyors;" Be it 14 and 15 Vic., therefore enacted, &c.,

That any transmission or deposit of Articles or Indentures, to or Transmission with the Secretary of the Board before which the applicant is to be or deposit of Indentures examined, made since the first day of January now last, or which within a cershall be made during the six months next after the passing of this tain time to be Act, shall be of the same effect to all intents and purposes of law, purposes of as if such transmission or deposit had been made within the period prescribed by the Act first above cited, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.
