VII. And be it enacted, That the general meetings of the said Corporation, and all the meetings of the said Committee of Management, shall be held in such manner, after such notice, upon such requisition, at such times and at such places in the City of Quebec, as shall be directed by the By-laws of the Corporation then in force; at which meetings the President shall preside, or in his absence the senior Vice President, or in the absence of both, the second Vice President, and in case of the absence of the President and both the Vice Presidents, the meeting may call some other member of the Committee to the chair; and the presiding officer at any such meeting shall have full power and authority to keep order thereat. 5

VIII. And be it enacted, That the said Corporation shall not be dissolved, or the property thereof divided among the members, except under the provisions of a By-law passed by the consent of at least nine tenths of the members of the said Corporation, nor unless such By-law shall provide for, and the funds of the Corporation shall be sufficient to meet the payment of all demands against the Corporation. 20

Public Act.

IX. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be deemed a Public Act, and as such shall be judicially noticed by all Courts of Justice, Judges and others whomsoever, without being specially pleaded. 25
