Debentures to be distinguished from those issued under other Acts, &c.

V. And be it enacted, That the Debenunder this Act tures issued under this Act shall be distinguished from those issued under other Acts. and that separate accounts shall be kept thereof, and of all money expended under this 5 Act: and that such accounts shall be laid annually before the Provincial Parliament; and that the due application of all money expended under this Act shall be accounted for to Her Majesty, through the Lords Com- 10 missioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, in such manner and form as Her Majesty shall please to direct.

Governor may appoint Commissioners under this Act

VI. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Governor to appoint five per- 15 sons to be Commissioners under this Act. and from time to time to remove them or any of them, and to appoint another or others in the place of any so removed, or dying, or 20 resigning office.

Oath to be ta ken by Commissioners

VII. And be it enacted, That each of the said Commissioners shall, before entering upon the duties of his office, take and subscribe, before any Justice of the Peace, the following oath:

The oath

" I. , swear that I will faith-"fully and without partiality, fear, favour or "affection, perform my duty as Commis-"sioner under the Act intituled, "An Act " &c. (insert the title of this Act,) and that I 30 " will allow to each claimant under the said "Act, neither more nor less than the sum " which he is entitled to claim for compensa-"tion, according to the true intent and mean-"ing of the said Act. So help me God." 35 Which oath shall be entered on the minutes of the proceedings of the said Commissioners, and make part thereof.

A Cerk may be appointed to the said Commissioners.

VIII. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time 40 to appoint a Clerk to the said Commissioners, and the same to remove, and in case of
