

Licenses to
pedlars, &c.

17. Every local council may from time to time make, alter, or repeal by-laws for the granting of licenses to pedlars and other travelling traders and artists, and for preventing them from carrying on their traffic or practicing their art or calling without being licensed thereto.

Local coun-
cils may oblige
all traders
to take and
pay for
licenses.

18. Every local council may compel all traders, whether wholesale or retail, to take out and pay such council for a license to keep a shop or store, and may regulate the amount to be paid for such license; but such amount shall not exceed twenty dollars. 5
