Licenses to pedlars, &c.

17. Every local council may from time to time make, alter, or repeal by-laws for the granting of licenses to pedlars and other travelling traders and artists, and for preventing them from carrying on their traffic or practicing their art or calling without being licensed thereto.

Local councilsmayobiige all traders to take and Ipay for icenses.

Every local council may compel all traders, whether wholesale 5 or retail, to take out and pay such council for a license to keep a shopor store, and may regulate the amount to be paid for such license; but such amount shall not exceed twenty dollars.
