

Fort George, 12th August 1817.

Dear Sir

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of
 your letter of the 9th instant, with its inclosures, and
 as the several persons mentioned in the Pension
 list have not yet received the pay authorised,
 I shall immediately attend to their claims. I
 wrote some time ago to Tucker respecting the
 Pension list, which I suppose must have
 been misplaced.

I received a letter some time since from
 the Commissary General, dated the 9th Decr last,
 directing me to deliver for the use of the
 Grand River Indians, a quantity of Condemned
 Provisions in store at Fort Erie, and altho
